

MODEL 78162 DETROIT ENGINE STAND ADAPTER INSTRUCTIONS

(53 Series in-line 6 cyl., 6V & 8V also 71 Series in-line 6 cyl., 6V, 8V & 12V also 92 Series 6V & 8V also 8.2 liter V-8 and 6L71)

The Detroit engine mounting adapter is used with the universal mounting adapter that is included with the Norco diesel engine stand. The universal mounting adapter consists of a mounting plate that bolts directly to the engine stand drive shaft and two plates that bolt to opposite sides of the mounting plate.

WARRANTY

This product is covered by a Limited Lifetime Warranty. For details see the back cover of Norco's product catalog.

A WARNING

Always make sure engine stand adapter plates and engine setup are secure and stable before removing engine lifting device. This means all bolts and screws must be grade 8, the proper length, and fully tightened.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. On a horizontal plane, determine where the engine's center of balance is located. It is usually located approximately 2" above the centerline of the crankshaft.
- 2. Remove the side plates from the universal adapter plate and attach them loosely to the engine mounting adapter. The engine mounting adapter should already be attached to the engine.
- 3. Position the engine with the engine stand so the engine's center of balance is approximately in-line with the engine stand's drive shaft. Next, align the holes in the universal side plates with the closest tapped holes in the universal adapter plate. Tighten all bolts that secure the side plates to the engine mounting adapter and the universal mounting plate adapter on the engine stand.
